



Decorators' White Paint

- for interior walls and ceilings

- well-covering, breathable interior wall paint



Application rate	Ca. 1 $I/7~m^2$. Determine the exact coverage by applying a test coat to the object
Areas of use	For mineral substrates (e.g. masonry, concrete, plaster) and construction slabs, wallpaper and old dispersion coatings
Property profile	Wet abrasion resistance class III DIN EN 13300 and hiding power class II DIN EN 13300 at 7 m2 per litre
Directions	Substrates must be clean, dry, free of grease and capable of supporting a load; remove loose parts Wash off distemper and chalking substrates Use primer to strengthen sanding and absorbent substrates Surface dry after approx. 2-3 hours, can be painted over after approx. 6 hours
Notes	The standard safety measures must be observed even when using low-pollutant paints and varnishes Please secure the container against falls and spills during transport.
Tools / Cleaning	Brush, paint roller, airless spraying equipment Clean the tools immediately after use with warm water and household cleaner, if necessary
Storage / Shelf life	Store in the sealed original container in a cool, dry, and frost-free place. Can be used for at least 1 year after the date of purchase Keep containers tightly closed and store upright to prevent spillages
Disposal	P501 Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.
VOC content as per the "Decopaint" Directive (2004/42/EC)	EU limit value for the product (Cat. A/a): max. 30 g/l (2010). This product contains < 1 g/l VOC.
